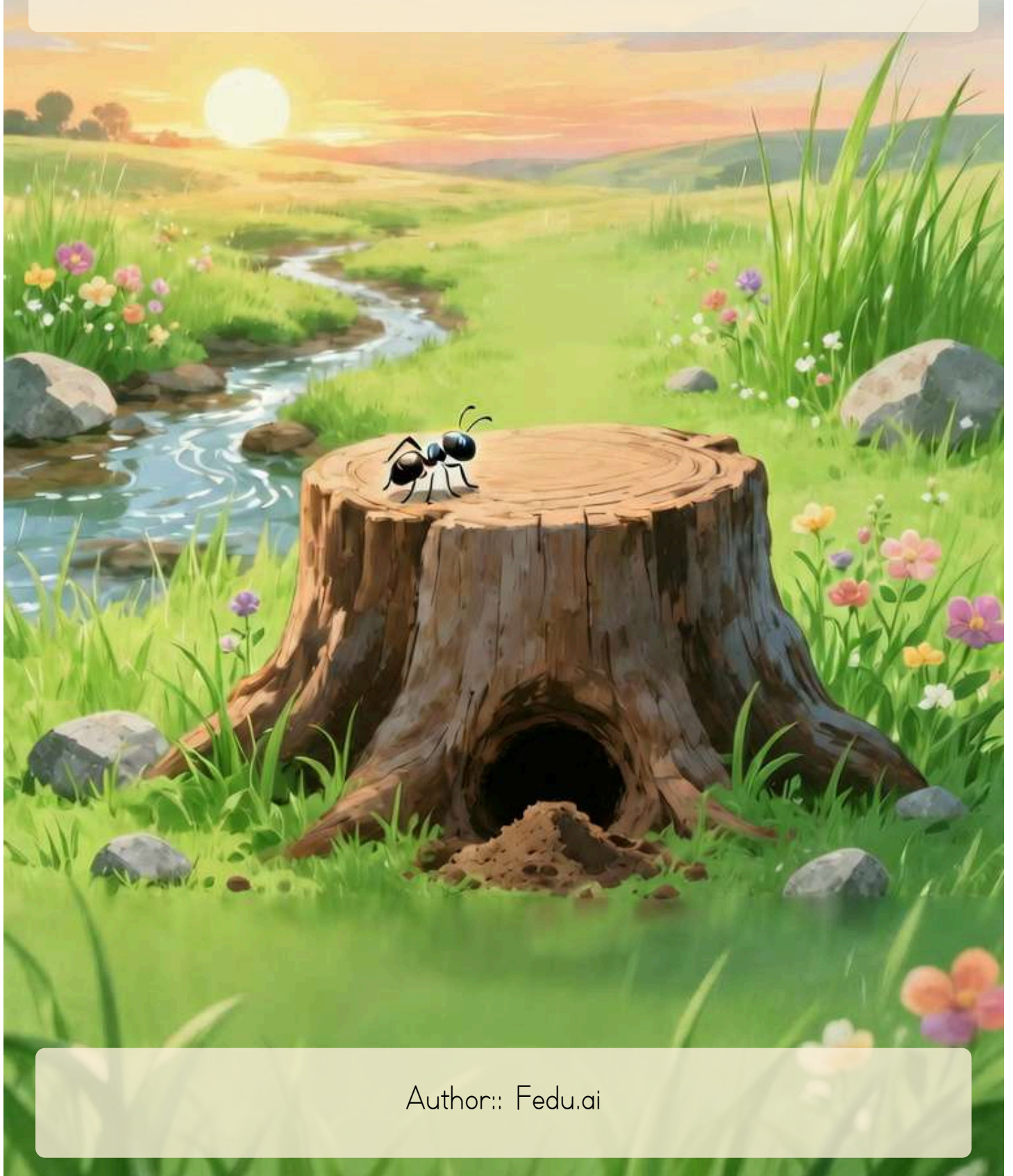


# The Wise Little Ant



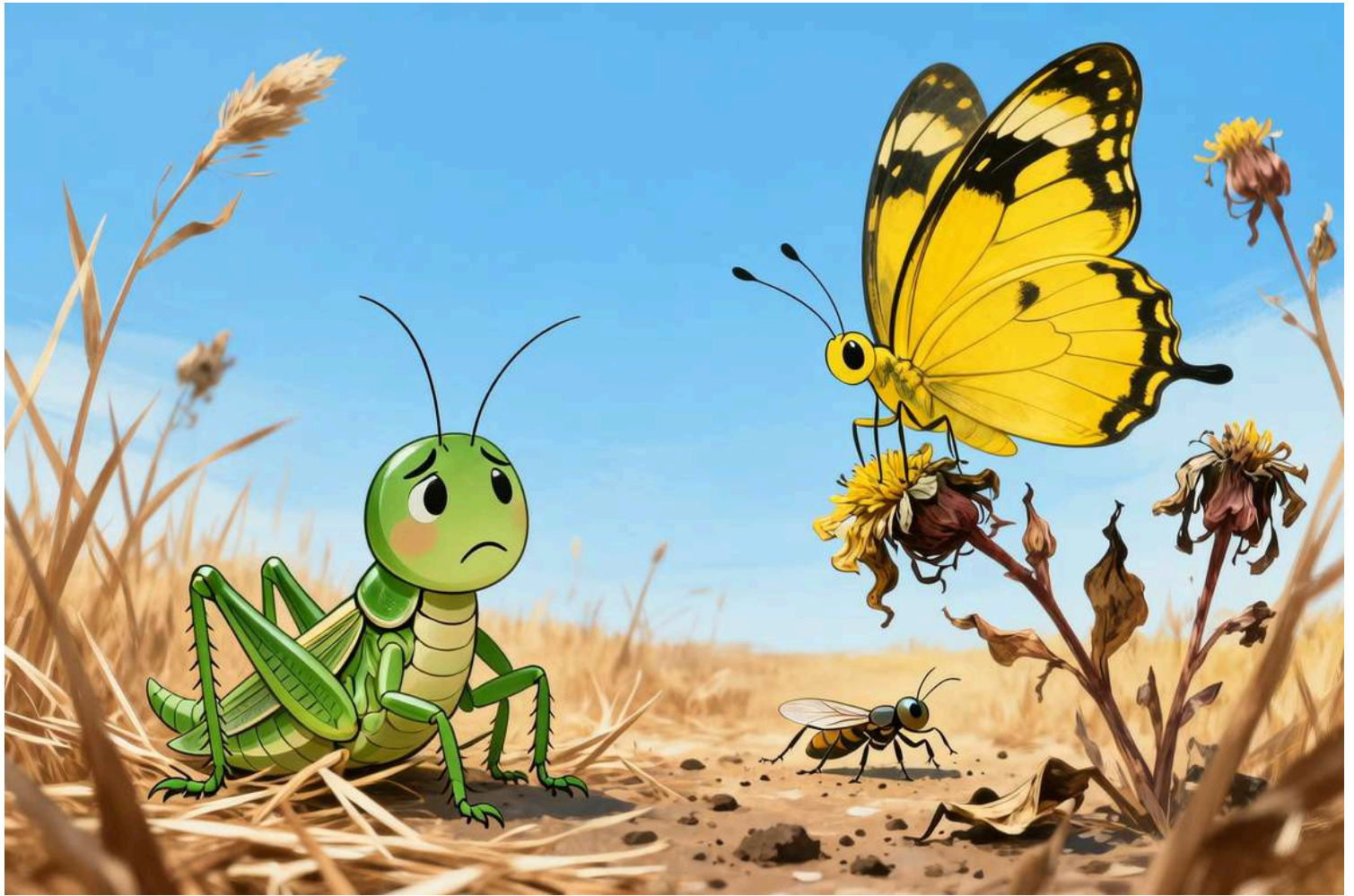

In a small meadow, many insects lived together. There were grasshoppers, butterflies, beetles, and ants. They were all friends and played together every day.



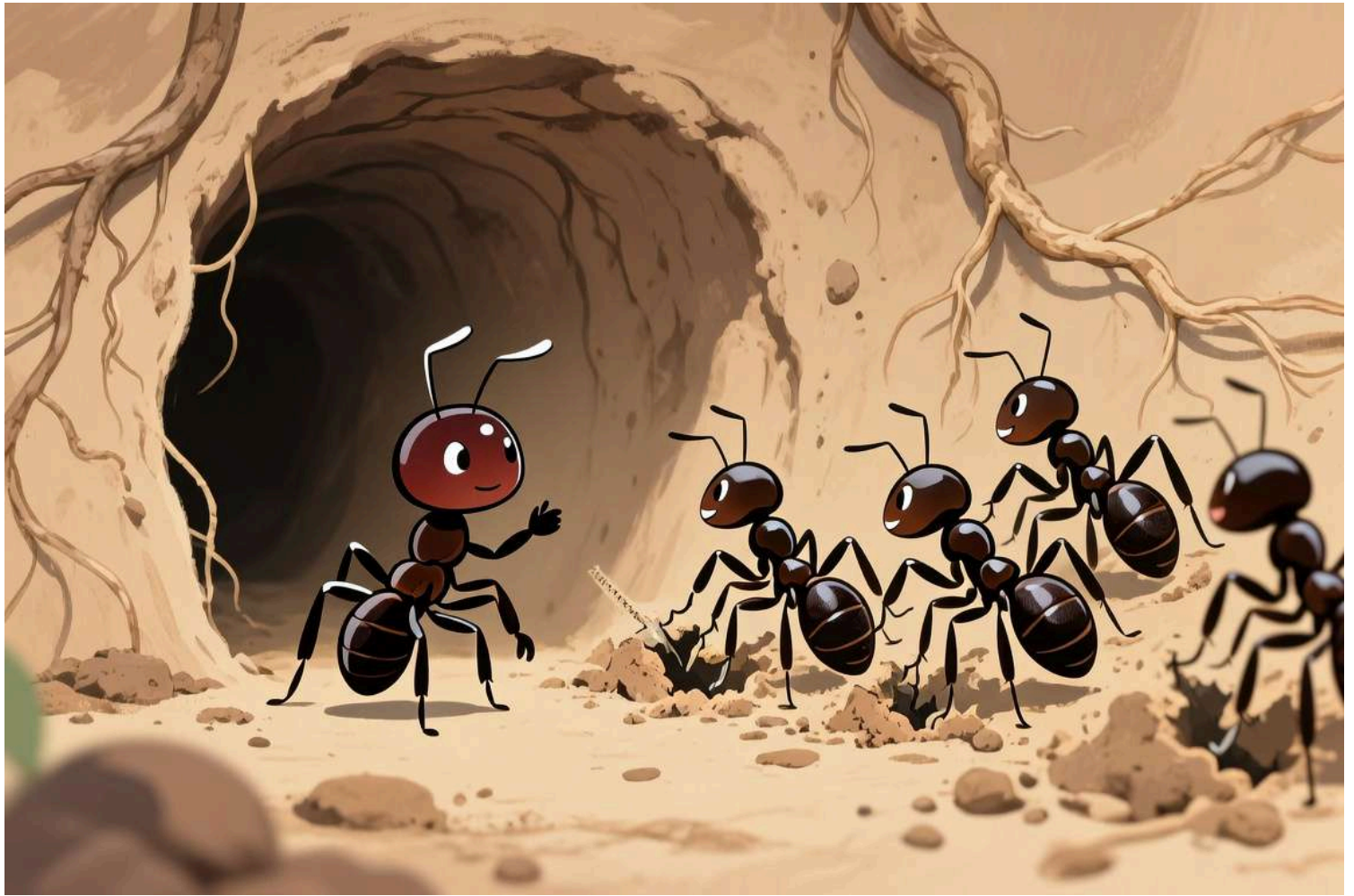
One summer, something strange happened. The rain stopped coming. The sun was very hot every day. The grass turned brown, and soon the flowers began to die.

Andy talked to his ant family. "We must dig deeper tunnels," he said. "We can find water under the ground." The other ants listened and started digging.



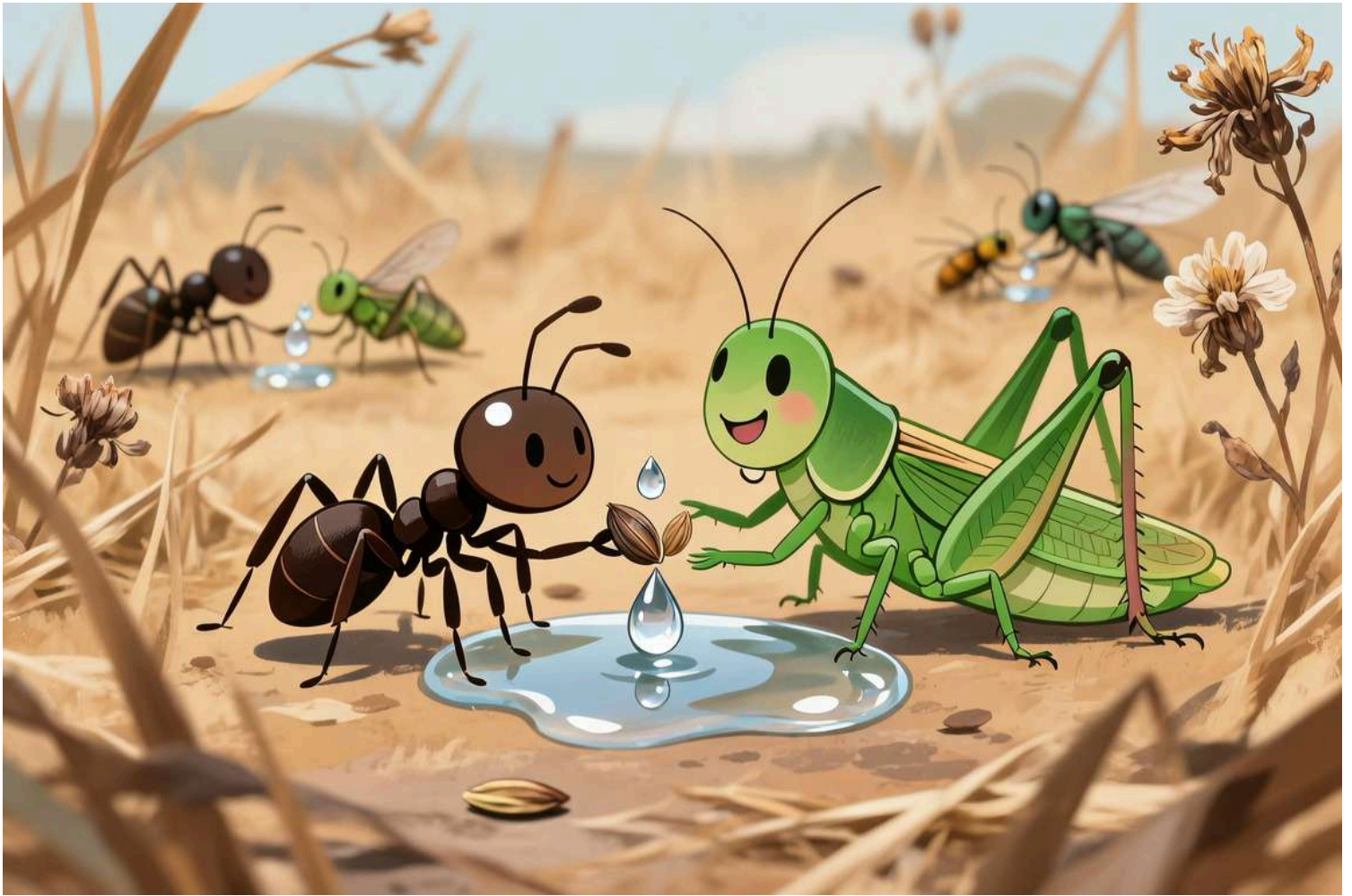
Every morning, Andy woke up early to collect tiny drops of water from the leaves. He taught other insects how to save these drops, too.
